

Sisterhood Bingo Connection

Rules of the Game

There is no cost to play.

Prizes will be awarded at the end of the night.

In order for our game to not be considered gambling, players must be members of CBS or related to a member of CBS. Relatives of CBS members cannot win prizes, but their CBS member can win on their behalf. (In other words, if your sister signs in from Minnesota, and she wins a game, you will receive the prize, and not her.)

Prizes are capped at two per player.

In order to be eligible for the grand prize drawing, you must be registered by August 5th.

How the game is played:

Before the game, be sure to click the link below to download your BINGO card. Clicking the link will randomly assign you a card. Print directly from the page, or save the image to download. Also remember to print out your bingo sign (link below).

DO NOT PLAY THE GAME USING THE LIVE WEBPAGE! Download or print your card image. Using the live webpage may crash our CBS website (and we don't want to give Hayim a headache 😊)!

We are assuming everyone knows the basics of how to play BINGO. If you need a refresher, please call Meri.

We will begin with a short conversation and welcome time as we make sure everyone is able to log in successfully. When we begin, all players will be muted.

For our online game, we will have Meri and Beth taking turns calling numbers. They will have cards with the numbers printed on them, and will show them on screen. A "game secretary" will type the number into the chat, so that players can go back and check if they get lost.

Listen to the rules for BINGO for each game – there will be two sessions – each session will include normal games and one "special" game with slightly different rules for winning. There will be a brief intermission between the sessions.

When you get a BINGO, unmute yourself and yell BINGO, and remember to wave your bingo sign too! This will help our game judges to find you quickly in gallery view (as well as assist should unmuting take a few extra seconds). We will confirm and record your win, then begin a new game.
